

## 2013 VFP Proposed Resolutions

### 2013-10: Impeachment Of President For War Crimes - 2013 VFP Letter To Congress

Whereas, following the passage of resolution 2011-7 to impeach the current Democrat President Obama for War Crimes, the VFP National President wrote in an email to the resolution's sponsor that he would issue a signed letter to members of the U.S. Congress in regards to the passed resolution 2011-7 as was done on 19 March 2005 following the passage of the 2004 resolution to impeach the former Republican President Bush, yet he later abdicated that duty to the temporary VFP Executive Director, an unelected position of a paid administrator, who would do no more than send a fax of resolution 2011-7 itself with a one-sentence statement on a fax cover-page that the resolution was passed at the recent VFP national convention, and

Whereas, multiple attempts were made by the sponsors of resolution 2011-7 during the months between the resolution's passage at the 2011 VFP national convention and the lead up in July 2012 to the 2012 VFP national convention to get the VFP National President to issue a letter to members of Congress in regards to the passage of the 2011-7 impeachment resolution similar to the letter sent by the VFP National President on 19 March 2005 in regards to the passage of the 2004 resolution calling for the impeachment of the Republican President Bush, yet the national president of VFP in an email to the sponsors of resolution 2011-7 stated that she would not issue the letter and that the national office would have nothing more to do with resolution 2011-7, and

Whereas, members of VFP's national leadership when asked about producing and sending a letter to members of the U.S. Congress over the past 2 years since passage of the 2011-7 impeachment resolution have responded to members of VFP that they were free to pursue the impeachment effort at the local level yet still to this day VFP's national office has not provided VFP's membership the same tools such as the downloadable flyer and letter to Congress that it had provided in regards to the passage of the 2004 resolution calling for the impeachment of the former Republican President George W. Bush, and

Whereas, since the passage of resolution 2011-7, the war crimes cited in that passed resolution have not only been continued unabated but the Democrat President Obama has expanded his list of crimes to include (1) targeting and assassinating American citizens without due process, and (2) threatening an illegal U.S. war of aggression on Syria, thus leading to even stronger support amongst the American people and members of VFP alike to call for the impeachment of the Democrat President Barack H. Obama;

Therefore Be It Resolved that no later than 3 weeks after passage of this resolution the current VFP National President (1) update the 19 March 2005 letter VFP sent to each member of the U.S. Congress calling on them to impeach the former Republican President Bush so as to reflect VFP's passed resolution 2011-7 calling on the U.S. Congress to impeach the current Democrat President Obama and sign his name to it, (2) send a copy of the letter to each member of the U.S. Congress as was done in regards to the 2004 VFP passed resolution calling for the impeachment of the former Republican President Bush, and (3) make available for download as a document file on the VFP national website a copy of the updated letter to the U.S. Congress as was done in regards to VFP's 2004 passed impeachment resolution, and

Be It Further Resolved that (1) to the extent that VFP's national office is unable to carry out the work called for in fulfilling this resolution, the sponsors of this resolution will perform the work required, and (2) to the extent that VFP's national office is unable to fund the mailing of the VFP National President's Letter to members of Congress, the sponsors of this resolution will provide the funding required.
